JT² – Trek to Annapurna Conservation Area – Detailed Itinerary

Duration: 6 Days/ 5 Nights

DAY 1 - ARRIVAL AT KATHMANDU

Comrades will arrive at Kathmandu and be welcomed by Team Junoon. Taxis will take them to hotel to relax and freshen up. The evening will be free for exploring surroundings. Day will culminate with a taste of local culture and traditional Newari Dinner.

Accommodation: Grand Hotel/ Hotel Vaishali @ Kathmandu – 3 Star facilities
(MEALS: DINNER)

DAY 2 – FLIGHT TO POKHARA AND DAY OF ADVENTURE

Guests will check out of Hotel in morning and will be transferred to domestic airport to board flight for Pokhara. Taxis will transfer them to hotel. Rest of the day is free to explore the 'Adventure Capital of Asia'. Pokhara is an amazing destination where backpackers from around the world converge to enjoy nature and begin their treks. Situated next to a mighty Himalayan panorama, this place is the gateway for some of the toughest treks in the world, including the elusive Annapurna Base Camp. The place also offers breathtaking adventure experiences including bungee jumping, paragliding, microlight flight, zipline, water rafting, flight around Mt. Everest and so on. Guests can choose the activity they like and experience adventure in Nepal.

Accommodation: Hotel Lakeside Retreat @Pokhara – 3 Star facilities
(MEALS: BREAKFAST)

DAY 3 – DRIVE TO KANDE (1700 M) AND TREK TO AUSTRALIAN CAMP (2400M/8KMS)

After Breakfast, guests will check out from hotel and will move to Kande via road. Their backpacking experience begins from this point. The 8km trek will bring the participants to Australian Camp with amazing panoramic views of mountains like Machhapuchhre, Annapurna I, Annapurna II, Annapurna III Annapurna IV and Annapurna South. Night will be spent, backpacker-style, either in camp or in Tea House/Lodge.

Accommodation: Camping/ Tea Houses/ Lodge – Backpacker style facilities)
(MEALS: BREAKFAST – Hotel , LUNCH, DINNER - Camp)

DAY 4 - TREK BACK TO KANDE (8KMS)

Post breakfast the group will depart for trek to Kande from where they will be transported back to Pokhara. The rest of the day will be free for rest and leisure. Being the gateway for some of the most popular and challenging treks in the world, Pokhara attracts tourists from almost every country. It is a cultural melting pot where people can enjoy and explore different cuisines, lifestyles and shopping opportunities.

Accommodation: Hotel Lakeside Retreat @Pokhara – 3 Star facilities

(MEALS: BREAKFAST – Camp)

DAY 5 – DRIVE BACK TO KATHMANDU (8HRS)

Post breakfast, the group will check out of hotels and depart for Kathmandu via road. The drive offers stunning vistas of Himalayan mountains and is an opportunity not-to-be-missed. After check-in at hotel in Kathmandu, guests are free to explore the city and the international tourist/shopping district of Thamel. The thriving culture and nightlife of the place is inspiring.
